Scratching's as per ACA Rule D.5.

JUVENILE RIDERS

Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Juveniles can compete on any status of horse except stallions.

If a Juvenile competitor was eligible to ride in Juvenile events in the 2019/20 competition, year they can ride in the Juvenile event at the National Finals. That is, to classify as a Juvenile rider at the National Finals, you must have been aged 13 years and under 17 years between 1 April 2019 and the National Finals being held.

STATUS

The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft.
