★ Local Business Teams Challenge ★

\$100 nomination fee per team

One round only. \$100 nomination per team.

Maximum of 15 teams - open only to businesses local to 4416 postcode.

Invited local teams will have priority. Any remaining team positions may be filled on the weekend - t-nominated at Secretary's box before Saturday 30th May 12pm.

PRIZE MONEY \$600 - Pays to 3rd Place - 1st \$300, 2nd \$200, 3rd \$100

RESTRICTED to one horse per rider only. Each team must nominate three individual riders, only one competitor to ride at a time. The team with the highest total aggregate score of all three riders will be the winner.

Open to Maiden aged riders only. All competitors must be financial ACA members.

Event to be held Saturday night under lights.

NOTE: this event does not break horse or rider status.

Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines

1. All competitors must be current 2026 financial members of the ACA. Nominations will be limited and numbers are restricted to the first fully paid first round nominations received. For Casual Memberships please see (17).
2. ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
3. Horses to be nominated in order in which horses are to be ridden.
4. Nomination fees include a \$10 stock levy.
5. Scratchings received within seven days of the draft will forfeit a \$10 fee.
6. Scratchings received after four days from the beginning of the event will forfeit the whole nomination amount, unless there are extenuating circumstances.
7. Campdraft competitors must hold themselves ready to compete at the advertised starting time on the day of draft. If the competitor fails to appear nomination fees paid or due shall be forfeited to Condamine Campdraft Committee.
8. All competitors compete at own risk.
9. All prize money listed is GST inclusive.
10. Refunds and prize money will be paid out by direct deposit following the event. To receive payment promptly competitors are requested to ensure their current banking details are provided on Campdraft Central.
11. Per ACA rule B5 (e) Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets in the main arena.
12. Junior competitors under the age of 13 are not permitted to compete in any drafts other than the Junior Draft.
13. The committee reserves the right to alter the program without notice.
14. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be paid when the complaint is lodged. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
15. All competitors must complete a horse health declaration form attached to this program, and hand to the Secretary's Office upon arrival at the Condamine Sports Grounds.
16. The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Mini, Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft)
17. Neither the organising committee nor the Western Downs Council accept any liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to horses, riders, beast or any other person or property whatsoever.
18. Casual Memberships will be accepted for any event in this draft. Anyone who wishes to nominate for the draft must ring in the office and pay the \$25 for a Casual Membership profile. Event Membership fee of \$100 must then be paid to the committee.

I AGREE TO ENSURE THAT:

1. If required before movement, all horses will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horses should be in a clean condition at the start of travel to the Condamine Campdraft.
3. The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
4. I agree to abide by all conditions and directions of the Condamine Campdraft Committee.
5. I acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue, disqualification or other disciplinary action as decided by the Judiciary/Disputes Committee.
6. In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s including feeding and watering.

Casual Memberships & Event Fees



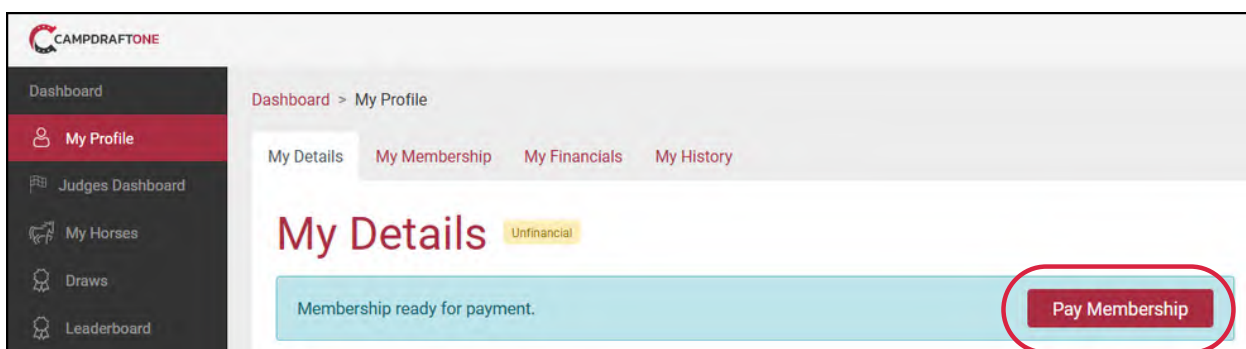
\$25 - Casual ACA Membership Fee. This is an annual membership type that allows members to nominate for events where casual memberships are accepted. Casual Membership can not be upgraded to another membership throughout the year.

How do I become a Casual Member if I don't have a Campdraft One profile?

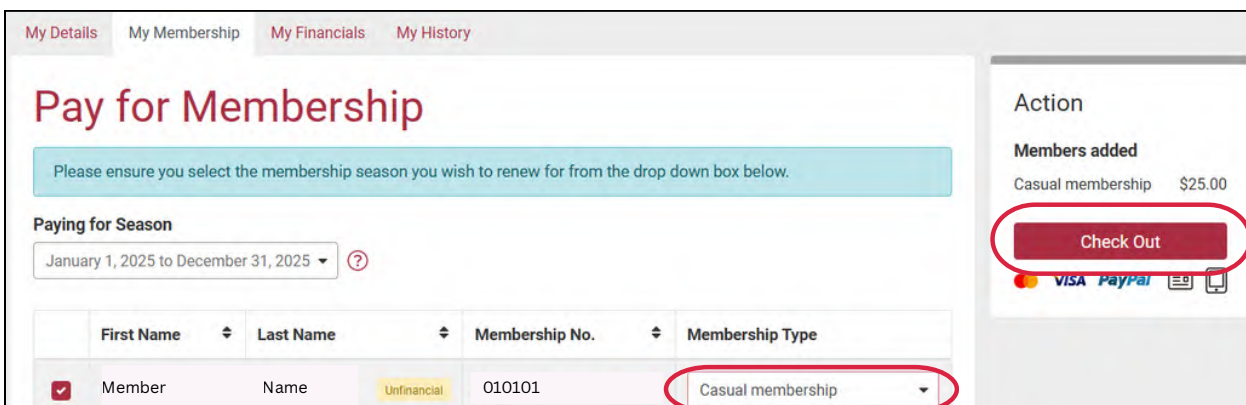
1. To become a Casual Member of ACA if you do not yet have a Campdraft One account, visit the ACA website and find the New Member Application Form under the Contact Us tab or call the ACA Office during office hours to create a Campdraft One profile. PH: (07) 4622 3110.
2. Pay for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.

How do I become a Casual Member if I already have a Campdraft One profile?

1. Sign into your Campdraft One profile.
2. Go to 'My Profile'. Here you will see a blue banner directing you to pay your membership.



3. Select who you wish to pay the membership for, then select membership type, 'Casual Membership', select 'Check Out' and proceed to payment for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.



\$100 - Event Membership Fee: payable to the Committee once the nominations are accepted.

Now that I'm a Casual Member, what's next?

1. Once you are a Casual Member, you will be able to nominate for ACA affiliated events, where the committee is accepting Casual/Event Memberships (as advertised on the program).
2. If your nominations are accepted into an ACA affiliated event, you will then receive an invoice for the \$100 (GST inc.) Event Membership along with your nominations invoice.

Please note all ACA membership types are non-refundable.
