**1. NOMINATIONS:**

**NO PAYMENT NO RIDE, NOMINATIONS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE COMPETING**

A win will break status of rider and/or horse unless otherwise specified

Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed.

**2. MEDICAL PROVIDER - BEST MEDICS**

**3. PRIZE MONEY** - Prize money will be paid according to ACA Rules R.6- R.9

**4. JACK & JILL**

For competitors 17 years and over, who have not won 1x Encouragement or 1x Open age draft or placed 3x times in an open Campdraft. Horse will be verified with Station manager and reside within Tennant Creek DPIFM Boundary. Must be riding a Maiden station bred horse. Due to the added restrictions, this event is not an encouragement. As a result, the horse's status will break status in accordance with Rule 9.1 & Rule 9.2. HELMETS MUST BE WORN. 1 run limit in the Jack & Jill.

**5: JACKPOT PRIZE MONEY:** Campdraft events with jackpot prize money will be paid in accordance with ACA rule r.9.

**6. ENCOURAGEMENT:**

Competitors must be 17yrs & over, not won 1x Encouragement or 1x Open age Campdraft, or placed 3x times in an Open age Campdraft. A win will not alter the status of the horse. 1 run limit in the Encouragement.

HELMETS MUST BE WORN.

**7. HORSE AGE-** A horse age is of 1st August 2021 as per ASCA guidelines.

**8. ACA** - ACA affiliated - all competitors must be financial ACA members.

**9. REFUNDS** - All refunds as per ACA guidelines.

**10. OPEN DRAFT** - No horse restriction in the open (all horse status accepted).

**11. ENCOURAGEMENT CHALLENGE** - Rider not to have previously won a challenge, any age horse.

**12. CHALLENGES** -The Challenges are not ACA affiliated.

**13. HARRY REDFORD TROPHY** - Please complete the Harry Redford Trophy Nomination Form.

This is run in conjunction with the Tennant Creek Campdraft & awarded to the Jack & Jill with the highest aggregate points from both Campdraft's.

Encouragement riders who wish to be eligible for this trophy must be employed on a station, riding a maiden station bred horse, nominated by the station manager / owner and residing within the Tennant Creek DPI&F boundary.

## **1. AFFILIATION:**

Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the General Information Competition Rules and Guidelines.

## **2. HELMETS:**

Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

## **3. SCRATCHING:**

A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

## **4. HORSE'S STATUS:**

The status of a horse winning a Campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Men's, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts.

## **5. NOMINATION:**

Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed.

## **6. ENCOURAGEMENT:**

An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open age draft, or placed 3 times in an Open age campdraft.

## **7. JUVENILE/JUNIOR/MINI:**

Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years), Juniors (8 years to under 13 years) and Mini's (Under 8's).

## **8. OPEN AGE EVENTS DISCLOSURE:**

All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program

## **9. COMPLAINTS:**

*"Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited".*

# Casual Memberships & Event Fees





## How do I become a Casual Member if I don't have a Campdraft One profile?


1. To become a Casual Member of ACA if you do not yet have a Campdraft One account, visit the ACA website and find the New Member Application Form under the Contact Us tab or call the ACA Office during office hours to create a Campdraft One profile. PH: (07) 4622 3110.
2. Pay for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.

## How do I become a Casual Member if I already have a Campdraft One profile?

1. Sign into your Campdraft One profile.
2. Go to 'My Profile'. Here you will see a blue banner directing you to pay your membership.



3. Select who you wish to pay the membership for, then select membership type, 'Casual Membership', select 'Check Out' and proceed to payment for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.



\$100 - Event Membership Fee: payable to the Committee once the nominations are accepted.

## Now that I'm a Casual Member, what's next?

1. Once you are a Casual Member, you will be able to nominate for ACA affiliated events, where the committee is accepting Casual/Event Memberships (as advertised on the program).
2. If your nominations are accepted into an ACA affiliated event, you will then receive an invoice for the \$100 (GST inc.) Event Membership along with your nominations invoice.
