### Conditions

1. All competitors ride at their own risk. The committee does not assume responsibility for accident or injury to contestants or their stock and by act of entry or participation the contestant waives all claims for injury, loss or damage either personally or to his/her helpers in any connection.
2. Any competitor not present by the third call will be disqualified without recourse.
3. Any competitor under the influence of liquor or drugs will be disqualified without recourse.
4. The committee reserves the right to alter, delete or vary any clause, condition or event on the program and its decision will be final in all cases.
5. LADIES DRAFT - Limited to 2 horses per competitor.
6. JUVENILE DRAFT - Limited to 2 horses per competitor.
7. Nominations close with the committee for all events by 8am Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026.
8. Nominations will not be accepted without payment.
9. Nominations will be refunded if scratchings are received by 8am Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June.
10. The draw for positions in the draft will be conducted on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June.
11. All events subject to stock availability.
12. Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
13. All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program.
14. WF (Wally) Vale Memorial Open Draft will break horse and rider status to open.
15. PRIZEMONEY
  - R.6 Prize money will be split in the following way.
    - Round Money:
      - Under \$500 - 4 ways
      - \$500-\$1000 - 6 ways
      - Over \$1000 - 8 ways
    - R.7 Committees pay at a minimum to sixth placing in all drafts.
    - R.8 Committees pay 8 places in all drafts with over 160 starters, 10 places in all drafts with 400 starts and 12 places in all drafts with 500 starters.
    - R.9 All prizemoney should be evenly divided using the following tables.
      - (a) (1) THREE ROUND DRAFT - 1 st Round 15%; 2 nd Round 15%, Aggregate 70%
      - (2) TWO ROUND DRAFT - 1 st Round 20%; Aggregate 80%
      - (b) (1) FOUR PLACES: 1 st 40%; 2 nd 30%; 3 rd 20%; 4 th 10%
      - (2) SIX PLACES: 1 st 25%; 2 nd 21%; 3 rd 18%; 4 th 15%; 5 th 12%; 6 th 9%
      - (3) EIGHT PLACES: 1 st 20%; 2 nd 18%; 3 rd 16%; 4 th 14%; 5 th 12%; 6 th 10%; 7 th 6%; 8 th 4%
      - (4) TEN PLACES: 1 st 20%; 2 nd 18%; 3 rd 14%; 4 th 12%; 5 th 10%; 6 th 8%; 7 th 6%; 8 th 5%; 9 th 4%; 10 th 3%
      - (5) TWELVE PLACES: 1 st 18%; 2 nd 16%; 3 rd 14%; 4 th 12%; 5 th 10%; 6 th 9%; 7 th 6%; 8 th 5%; 9 th 4%; 10 th 3%; 11 th 2%; 12 th 1%

# Casual Memberships & Event Fees



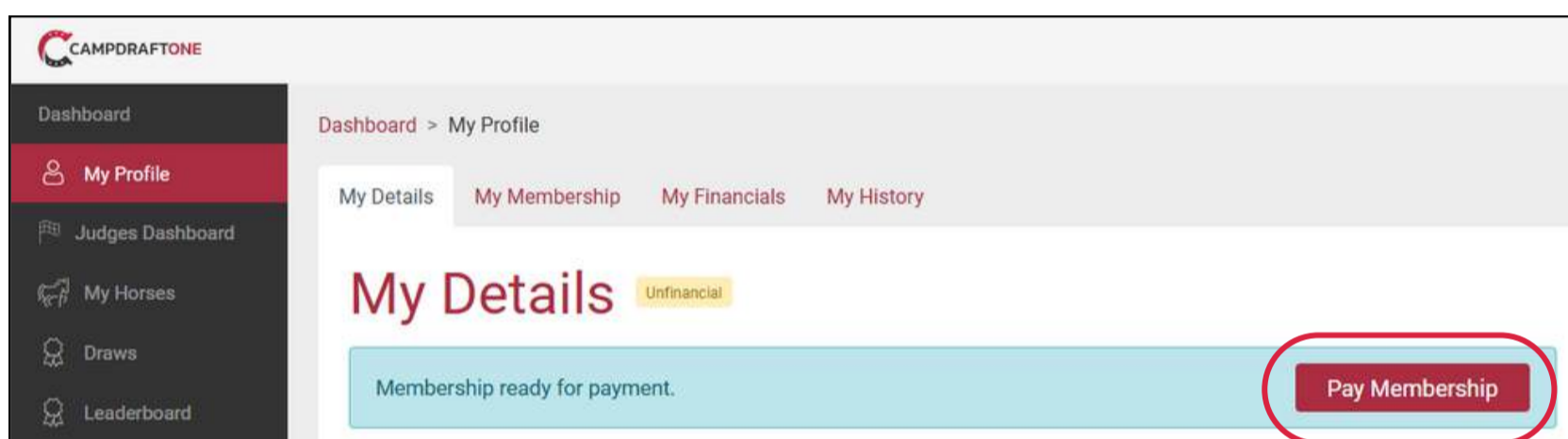
**\$25 - Casual ACA Membership Fee.** This is an annual membership type that allows members to nominate for events where casual memberships are accepted. Casual Membership can not be upgraded to another membership throughout the year.

## How do I become a Casual Member if I don't have a Campdraft One profile?

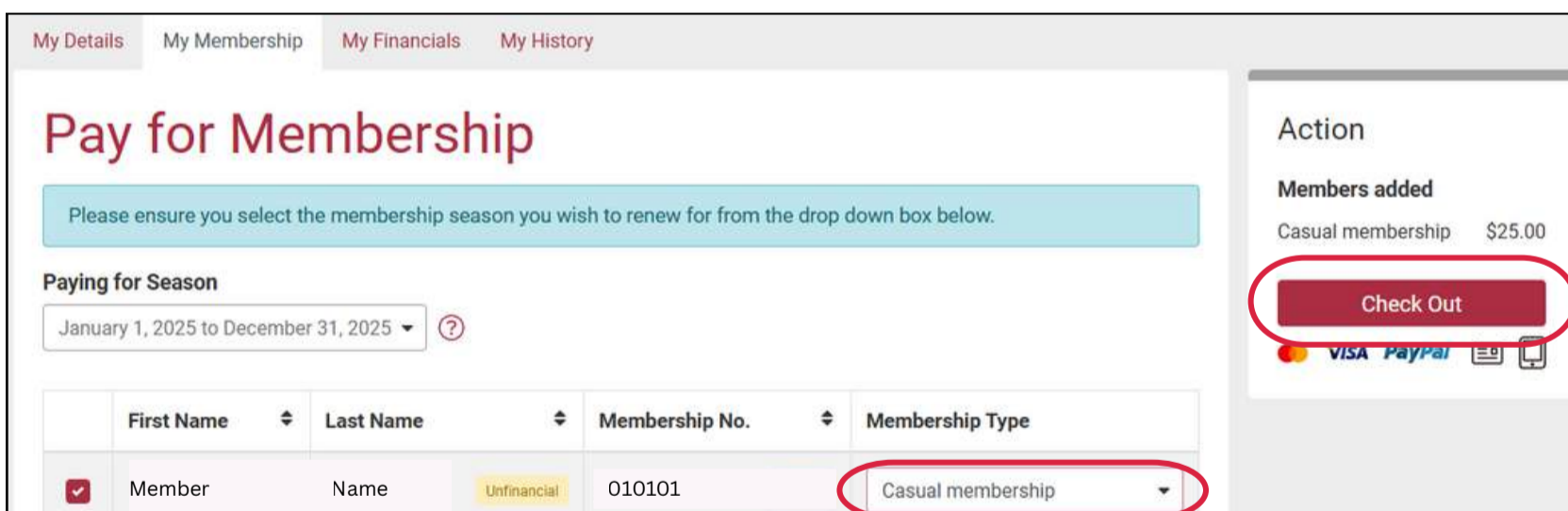
1. To become a Casual Member of ACA if you do not yet have a Campdraft One account, visit the ACA website and find the New Member Application Form under the Contact Us tab or call the ACA Office during office hours to create a Campdraft One profile. PH: (07) 4622 3110.
2. Pay for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.

## How do I become a Casual Member if I already have a Campdraft One profile?

1. Sign into your Campdraft One profile.
2. Go to 'My Profile'. Here you will see a blue banner directing you to pay your membership.



3. Select who you wish to pay the membership for, then select membership type, 'Casual Membership', select 'Check Out' and proceed to payment for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.



**\$100 - Event Membership Fee:** payable to the Committee once the nominations are accepted.

## Now that I'm a Casual Member, what's next?

1. Once you are a Casual Member, you will be able to nominate for ACA affiliated events, where the committee is accepting Casual/Event Memberships (as advertised on the program).
2. If your nominations are accepted into an ACA affiliated event, you will then receive an invoice for the \$100 (GST inc.) Event Membership along with your nominations invoice.

Please note all ACA membership types are non-refundable.
