CAMPDRAFT & CHALLENGE TERMS

- Campdrafts affiliated with the ACA and run in accordance to their rules and guidelines.
- ACA Requires all competitors to ensure all details match ACA Campdraft One details ie: rider name, horses names in other nomination platforms.
- Challenges run under ASCA rules.
- Horses and owners only be eligible for prize money if ALL of the following conditions are complied with.
- Nominations Open Wednesday 6th August 5pm and close Friday 8th August 5pm.
- **ALL competitors will need to be Current Financial ACA Members to compete in the campdraft.**
- **Stockmans Challenge Competitors will be required to have current ASCA Membership.**
- All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program
- Horses must compete in the correct age category where specified. Verification of age must be uploaded to campdraft one. A horse's birth date is taken as the 1st August.
- Any prize money will be paid to person nominating horse. Campdraft Prizemoney will be per ACA Rules.
- The status of horse will change according to the highest status horse in the campdraft events.
- Scratchings 100% Refund if received before 8am 3rd August after this date will forfeit the entire nomination fee.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a Challenge complaint in relation to an Event, must lodge the complaint in writing to the Secretary within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed, the \$50 fee is forfeited.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a Campdraft complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge a complaint in writing with the secretary host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be paid when lodged. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$100 is forfeited as per ACA rule 12.
- All rules as per relevant associations must be adhered to at all times, Competitors responsibility to read and understand rules and regulations prior to competing.
- All competitors under 18 years must wear a skullcap at all times when mounted on the grounds.
- Stallions containment regulations to be adhered to.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter the program and/or any terms and conditions.
- Changes need to be to the secretary's office within 2hrs hour of event starting.
- In the event that your power arrangement causes fault to the electrical supply and requires an electrician to visit the grounds the person responsible for the fault may be responsible for paying the electrician should it be deemed that your power arrangements were negligent.
- **Medical Service Provider - Country Style First Aid**
- All competitors will need to present to the secretary's office to receive a competitors armband. This will be provided once confirmation of all paperwork including payment of nominations, current memberships, horse health declarations and COVID compliance. A competitor will not be able to enter the camp or challenge arena without this armband.
- The Congress will not be held responsible for any competitor entering themselves or horses incorrectly. The Congress will direct any enquiries re this matter to the relevant association to contact those involved.

- **Stables must be booked when nominating on campdraft one.**
- Stables \$80 each for event duration.
- Stables must be cleaned before leaving the grounds and manure placed in allocated areas. Failure to do so will result in the committee receiving fines, these will then be passed onto users and will forfeit the opportunity to compete at future events.

Casual & Event Memberships




\$25 - Casual ACA Membership Fee. This is a type of annual membership that allows members to nominate for events where event memberships are accepted. Casual Membership can not be upgraded to another membership throughout the year.

How do I become a Casual Member if I don't have a Campdraft One profile?


1. To become a Casual Member of ACA if you do not yet have a Campdraft One account, call the ACA Office during office hours to create a Campdraft One profile. PH: (07) 4622 3110.
2. Pay for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.

How do I become a Casual Member if I already have a Campdraft One profile?

1. Sign into your Campdraft One profile.
2. Go to 'My Profile'. Here you will see a blue banner directing you to pay your membership.



3. Select who you wish to pay the membership for, then select membership type, 'Casual Membership', select 'Check Out' and proceed to payment for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.



\$100 - Event Membership Fee: payable to the Committee once the nominations are accepted.

Now that I'm a Casual Member, what's next?

1. Once you are a Casual Member, you will be able to nominate for ACA affiliated events, where the committee is accepting Event Memberships (as advertised on the program).
2. If your nominations are accepted into an ACA affiliated event, you will then receive an invoice for the \$100 (GST inc.) Event Membership along with your nominations invoice. Please note all ACA membership types are non-refundable.



- 1 Enter at A and walk towards B

- 2 At B turn right and trot to X

- 3 Trot a medium circle to the left

- 4 Trot a medium circle to the right

- 5 Halt at X

- 6 Demonstrate a spin to the left


- 7 Demonstrate a spin to the right

- 8 Trot a large circle to the left but do not close

- 9 Stop at B

- 10 Back up 3 steps. Salute Judge

- 1 Salute Judge at A. Walk to B. Trot to X (centre). Stop

- 2 2 spins to the right

- 3 2 spins to the left

- 4 From X, canter a large circle to the right on the correct lead

- 5 At X, do a simple change and canter a larger circle to the left on the correct lead


- 6 At X, do a simple change and canter to C on the right lead, Stop

- 7 Do a rollback to the left and canter to D on the left lead, Stop

- 8 Do a rollback to the right and canter on the right lead all the way past B

- 9 Stop, settle your horse, back your horse to the centre line. Stop

- 10 Turn and face the judge, salute and leave the arena on a loose rein

- ① At A Acknowledge Judge. Working Walk to B cracking the whip on a loose rein. At B gather whip and continue at working walk to X. At X stop.

- ② 2 spins to the left

- ③ 2 spins to the right

- ④ Canter a small slow circle left, Canter large fast circle left

- ⑤ At X do a flying change

- ⑥ Canter a small slow circle right, Canter large fast circle right


- ⑦ At X flying change, canter large fast to the left, do not close circle

- ⑧ Run down to A and stop, and without hesitation, do a right rollback

- ⑨ Run down to C and stop, and without hesitation, do a left rollback

- ⑩ Run down past B and stop. Settle horse and back up at least 5 paces. Acknowledge Judge

- 1 At A acknowledge judge and demonstrate horses acceptance of the whip. Trot to X. Halt.

- 2 3 spins to the right

- 3 3 Spins to the left

- 4 Gallop two large fast circles to the right, canter one small slow circle to the right.

- 5 At X flying change to the left.


- 6 Canter a small circle to the left, Gallop two large fast circles to the left.

- 7 At X flying change to the right.

- 8 At a working canter continue around the arena, at A run down and stop between the centre marker and B, Roll back to the Left.

- 9 Continue around the arena at a working canter at D run down and stop between the centre marker and C, Roll back to the right.

- 10 Run past the centre marker, stop, back up at least 6 paces. Acknowledge Judge. Leave arena at a walk on a loose rein.



- 1 Enter at A, working canter to X Stop, Hesitate.

- 2 Three spins to the left

- 3 Three and 1/4 spin to the right

- 4 Gallop large fast circle to the right. Canter small slow circle to the right.

- 5 Flying Change at X.

- 6 Canter small slow circle to the left. Gallop large fast circle to the left. Flying change at X.

- 7 Canter circle to the right but do not close.
Canter down to B, stop and roll back to the left.

- 8 Canter down to C stop and roll back to the right.

- 9 Canter down to D, stop, settle and back up 6 paces.

- 10 Exit arena at a working walk cracking the whip on a loose rein. Acknowledge judge to show completion of the pattern.
