DUNDEE BUSHMAN'S COMMITTEE

- ◆ *Once Draft has begun there will be no changes to the draw.*
- ◆ Competitors must agree to compete at their own risk and to hold free and indemnify the Committee against all claims, suits, actions or demands which may be brought against it in respect of any injuries or other loss sustained by the competitor, however caused as a result of competing in any event - and must agree to exonerate the Committee from all responsibility and from all loss or injury, whether due to alleged negligence or otherwise.
- ◆ Run under ACA rules. Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines.
- ◆ All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program.
- ◆ Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- ◆ **Status of a Horse:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Futurity, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- ◆ ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
- ◆ A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- ◆ Where applicable, competitors may be asked to sign statutory declarations, relating to age, and eligibility for entry in maiden events.
- ◆ Sporting events will be run against the clock.
- ◆ Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be paid when the complaint is lodged. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
- ◆ Casual ACA membership will be accepted for this draft.

The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program

Casual & Event Memberships


\$25 - Casual ACA Membership Fee. This is a type of annual membership that allows members to nominate for events where event memberships are accepted. Casual Membership can not be upgraded to another membership throughout the year.

How do I become a Casual Member if I don't have a Campdraft One profile?


1. To become a Casual Member of ACA if you do not yet have a Campdraft One account, call the ACA Office during office hours to create a Campdraft One profile. PH: (07) 4622 3110.
2. Pay for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.

How do I become a Casual Member if I already have a Campdraft One profile?

1. Sign into your Campdraft One profile.
2. Go to 'My Profile'. Here you will see a blue banner directing you to pay your membership.



3. Select who you wish to pay the membership for, then select membership type, 'Casual Membership', select 'Check Out' and proceed to payment for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.



\$100 - Event Membership Fee: payable to the Committee once the nominations are accepted.

Now that I'm a Casual Member, what's next?

1. Once you are a Casual Member, you will be able to nominate for ACA affiliated events, where the committee is accepting Event Memberships (as advertised on the program).
2. If your nominations are accepted into an ACA affiliated event, you will then receive an invoice for the \$100 (GST inc.) Event Membership along with your nominations invoice. Please note all ACA membership types are non-refundable.
