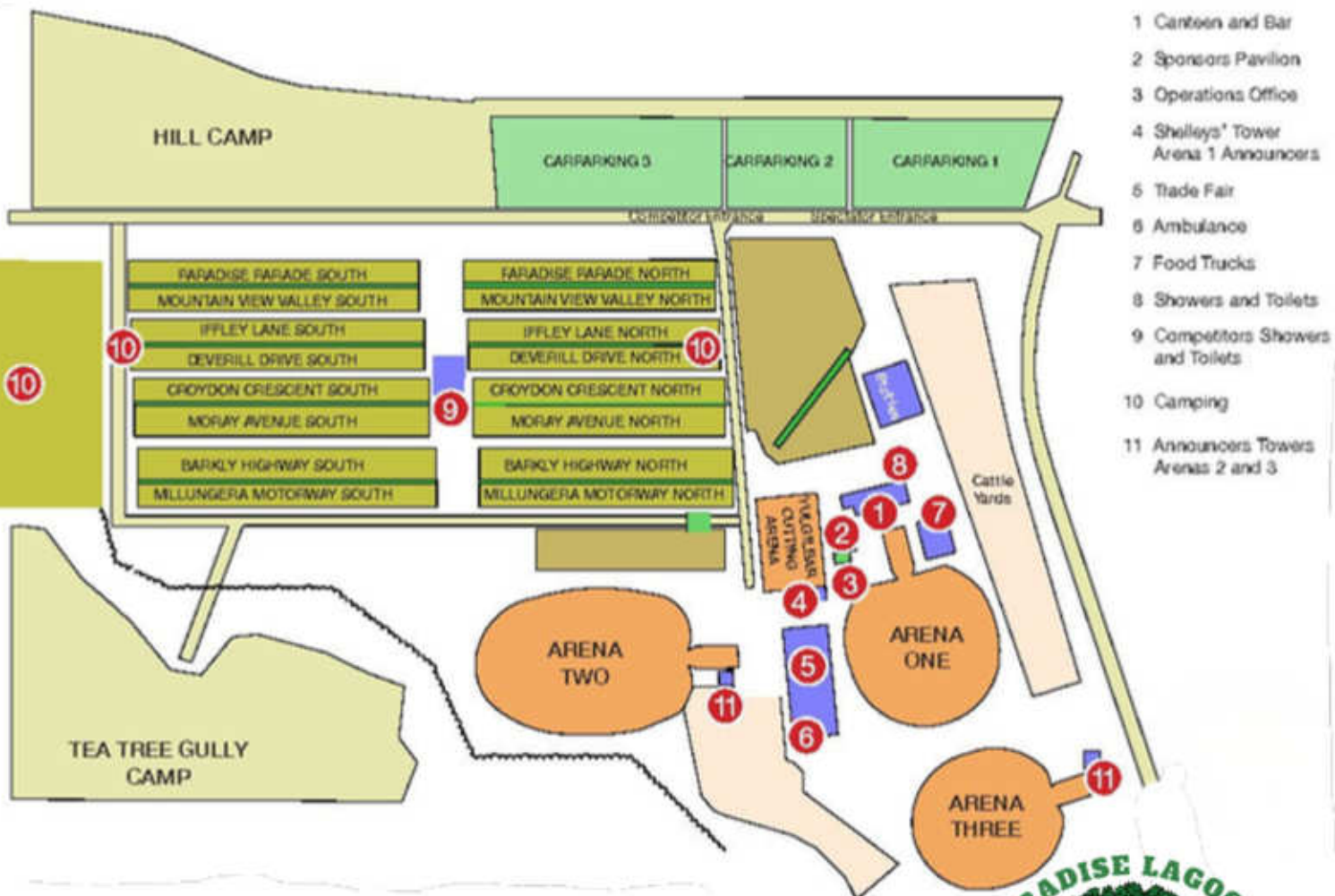

Terms & Conditions



The Paradise Lagoons Campdraft Committee is GST registered. All nominations include GST, a tax invoice is issued online at the time of nomination. For competitors wanting to claim GST on prize money, the ABN field in your Campdraft One profile must be ticked. All Prizemoney will be deposited directly into the competitor's nominated bank account unless otherwise advised. Please ensure bank details are correct in Campdraft One. Prizemoney paid as per ACA R.9 paid via Campdraft One. Please note that all Prizemoney, Refunds and Scratchings will not be processed until after the conclusion of the event.

All changes (ie run order, rider substitution and horse substitution) must be in the hands of the secretary by 5:00pm the afternoon before the draft. Only changes received by hard copy will be accepted over the course of the weekend. Forms will be available outside the secretary's office. NO changes are to be made after the event starts. Any changes to draws will incur a \$10.00 donation to CapRescue.

Ladies Draft and Juvenile Draft are limited to two entries per competitor. Juvenile riders turning seventeen (17) during the competition year are eligible to compete at the ACA National Finals in the Juvenile event. All Campdrafts are open to any rider thirteen (13) years and over at the date of competition. Riders under the age of eighteen (18) must comply with Rule B.5.E.iii of the ACA Rule Book.

A substitute horse will be allowed when the nominated horse cannot start. Name of substitute to be given to the Secretary one hour before the start of the draft (earlier if possible). Horse must be bona fide property of the nominee. A veterinary certificate must be produced one hour before the draft is run.

After closing date, refunds for scratchings will be subject to the following ACA rulings. Any scratchings will not be refunded unless a vet certificate is presented, or the committee receives photo or video proof that the horse cannot compete. Stock Levy of \$30.00 applies.

The decision of the Paradise Lagoons Campdraft Committee or all matters appertaining or incidental to the competition shall be final and conclusive and binding on all nominations for the competitions, and in addition, the committee reserves unto itself the right, at any time, without being liable for any loss or damage which may be sustained, to alter or postpone the date of the competition or cancel the same or to change the venue of the competitions.

Invitation events are handled by the ACA Office. There will be a deadline to RSVP once contacted. Once competitors have been contacted and a full list of RSVP's confirmed, there will be no changes to the invitation list.

Stallions – There are no horse stalls available. All Stallions must comply with Rule 11.11 of the ACA Rule Book.
No dogs allowed. (Assistance dogs are the only exception)
